The farmhouse of La Conche is situated in the Lot region of S.W. France, three minutes walk from the village of Lacave and Dordogne River.

The lush valley is dotted with numerous medieval villages, castles and monasteries, especially from the time of the hundred years war between England and France (1336 - 1431).

Flora and fauna abound particularly on the untouched upland areas of the Causse de Gramat national park.

We are offering this special price for groups of 8 or more people PLUS free board and accommodation for an accompanying tutor or organiser in return for some support.

Teaching is normally done in the mornings, leaving the afternoons to paint on location.

Accommodation is at La Conche which has 4 double bedrooms. If the house is full we can book single and double rooms in the village.

Continental breakfast (bread, jams, fruit, coffee or tea).

Lunch, which may be in the countryside or in the garden.

Evening meals include local recipes, produce and wine.

Special menus and vegetarian food is available on request.

*Bookings are usually for one week (7 nights) but longer and shorter stays can be arranged.

*There is a single room supplement of £40.

*Itineraries are flexible and non-painters are welcome (5% reduction)

*transport is available from Souillac station which is on the main Paris to Toulouse line or from the nearest airports: Rodez, Bergerac or Limoges.

Bed and breakfast is also available for groups and individuals who prefer to do their own thing.
